RULES OF ATTENDANCE:

1. The candidates who have been admitted into B.Ed. (ODL) Course have to fulfill the conditions laid-down for the attendance of students and pass the prescribed teaching examination both in Theory and Practical.
2. 75% of Attendance for Theory Classes and 100% of Attendance during the Contact Programmes related to Workshops, School-based activities and Internship Programme is compulsory as per NCTE norms.
3. In special cases the Director, Directorate of Distance Education (DDE) may condone deficiency of Attendance not exceeding 10% on the recommendation of the Principal based on Medical Certificate by an Authorized medical Officer approved by the Principal.
4. **Students who do not have adequate attendance will not be permitted to appear for theory and Practical Examinations.**
5. The names of Students who are continuously absent for seven days or more without any leave sanctioned or who do not maintain a minimum of 70% average attendance in any particular subject at a given time, will be given re-admission during the next Academic Year as per request of the candidate with permission of the Director, Directorate of Distance Education concerned.

GENERAL RULES FOR EXAMINATION:

1. All the Examinations of the University shall be held at S. K. University or at such places and on such dates as may be notified by DDE.
2. Application to appear for an Examination shall be made on the prescribed form, accompanied by three passport size photographs along with the necessary certificates.
3. The prescribed fee should be paid at the concerned Study Centre on or before the date fixed for this purpose. The Principal after verifying the eligibility of the candidates, shall forward the application to the Director, DDE, S.K. University, Anantapuram.

4. When a candidate's application is found to be in order, the DDE shall send the attested Hall Ticket with the candidates Photograph to the Principal of the Study Centre.
5. A candidate who fails to attend the examination for any reasons shall not be entitled to claim refund of the examination fee.
6. An eligible candidate who has been allowed to appear at the examination of the University once, but failed or absent may be permitted to appear at the same examination as Supplementary candidate along with next batch after paying examination fee only.
7. A candidate after being declared successful in an examination shall be given a certificates with mention about the year of the examination, the subject in which the candidate was examined and the division/grade in which the candidate was placed.

GUIDELINES FOR ANSWERING ASSIGNMENTS:

1. Assignments constitute the continuous evaluation which carries 20 marks in each subject. The candidates should answer compulsorily the assignments and it will be counted for the purpose of final result.
2. The main purpose of assignments is to test the student's comprehension of the course material sent to him and also helping him getting through the courses. The assignments are to be submitted to the DDE, S. K. University before the due date.
3. At the time of answering Assignments he/she has to study thoroughly the units of the lessons on which assignments are based. The answer should cover all the main points of the question.
4. The responses should be in candidates own hand writing. Print or typed answers will not be accepted. If pass marks are not obtained in any assignment, it should be resubmitted.
5. Each assignment should be answered and submitted separately in a booklet form using A4 size papers providing clear cut margins and sufficient space in between each answer. Spiral binding books are not accepted.
